Note: Only 30 hours of nursing credit will be accepted towards the BSN program. This requires both the completion of an applicable Associates degree in Nursing (AAS excluded) as well as a current active, unencumbered Registered Nursing license.

*Credit variances in academic placement and credit award can occur based on student course selections and APUS' program requirements.

†Per APUS' General Education Block policy, the student's APUS General Education requirements (excluding required) will be fulfilled on the merit of a conferred Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree. As the amount of transfer credit may not exceed the sum of transferrable credit the student earned, the amount of transfer credit applicable to the Electives will be reduced by the sum of General Education Block credit awarded.

^Non-Applicable Nursing Credit - 6 semester hours

In order to transfer courses to APUS, the student must earn a grade of "C" or better.

**Any transferable course not counted toward General Education or Core requirements may be taken. Please note, some courses such as developmental, practicum, internships, clinical, and vocational courses are not transferable.
