\*Credit variances in academic placement and credit award can occur based on student course selections and APUS' program requirements.

†Per APUS' General Education Block policy, the student's APUS General Education requirements (excluding required) will be fulfilled on the merit of a conferred Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree. As the amount of transfer credit may not exceed the sum of transferrable credit the student earned, the amount of transfer credit applicable to the Electives will be reduced by the sum of General Education Block credit awarded.

Note: In order to transfer courses to APUS, the student must earn a grade of "C" or better.
