PSYC512 Introduction to Industrial/Organizational Psychology

Course Description

This course provides an overview of the primary concepts and theory in industrial and organizational psychology, with an emphasis on understanding human behavior in organizations and the workplace. Concepts such as motivation, leadership, employee training and recruitment, performance measurement, and work/life balance will be discussed.

Course Learning Outcomes

1. Examine the history and evolution of I/O as a specialty field in psychology.
2. Apply I/O theory and research to work settings.
3. Evaluate ethical considerations involved in various I/O scenarios and case studies.
4. Examine the effects of worker satisfaction, motivation, and perception of workplace interactions on organizational outcomes.
5. Evaluate the effect of individual factors in the organization, discussing how these can be assessed throughout the organizational life cycle.
6. Identify and evaluate effective methods of recruitment, selection, and training.
7. Examine and apply approaches to performance measurement and evaluation.
